TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP:

- * Full Member: A full participating member with voting privileges and unlimited participation in krewe events. A full member must participate in one charitable/civic activity during the year. (Fees: One-time Initiation Fee + Yearly Dues)
- ** Nomad: A Nomad is anyone residing 150+ miles from the Tampa Bay area. Nomads are allowed to participate in three krewe events a year. Nomads will not have voting privileges. (Fees: Yearly Dues)
- *** Returning Member: A full participating member with voting privileges and unlimited participation in krewe events. A full member must participate in one charitable/civic activity during the year. (Fees: Yearly Dues)

Fees associated with membership: Initiation Fee (\$100.00) per person — First year only. Member Yearly Dues (\$400.00) per person — First year and subsequent years. Nomad Yearly Dues (\$175.00) per person/per year

KREWE OF ZINGARO FACT SHEET

The Krewe of Zingaro was founded in January 1997 and incorporated as, a not for profit, social and charitable organization. The Krewe goals are to provide fellowship among the members and the community, take part in charitable and non-political civic causes, and participate in various parades and celebrations in the Tampa Bay area.

The original Founders were:

The costumes and floats are based on colorful gypsy caravans that will create dashing romantic images of freedom and fun. Male and female members will be dressed in brightly colored shirts, blouses, pants and jewelry to emulate the raucous spirit seen around the Gypsy campfire. Sample costumes will be provided. Men will wear dark pants and take care not be mistaken for pirates.

The Krewe is governed by a member elected board. This board consists of a President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Community Service Coordinator, Float Coordinator and Immediate Past President. A King/Queen is an honorary elected position and will sit on the board as an advisor. The board members and Monarch will be elected from the membership in September of every year. The fiscal year runs October 1 to September 30. Committees of members are formed to manage activities, such as parades, floats, socials, etc.
